

Conditions of Entry



THE RADHARC AWARDS 2018

Category One:

An award for television documentaries broadcast for the first time on any free to air channel on the island of Ireland between Wednesday 14th September 2016 and Friday 21st September 2018.

Category Two:

An award for documentaries produced in Ireland for first time digital distribution during the same period.

The closing date for the receipt of all entries is Monday 1st October 2018.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- a) Entry forms must be downloaded from our website www.radharc.ie
- b) The entry must be a documentary of high artistic merit that addresses national or international topics of faith, morality, social justice, human rights, religion or heritage.
- c) Programme makers may belong to any or no religious group but the programme itself should portray positive human values and challenge the moral conscience of the audience.
- d) The tone of the documentary should reflect the ethos that motivated Radharc Films.
- e) Entries in Category One must have been broadcast on any free to air channel on the island of Ireland for the first time during the period Wednesday 14th September 2016 and Friday 21st September 2018.
Entries in Category Two must have been produced in Ireland for first time digital distribution in the same period.
- f) A separate application must be submitted for each entry. Multiple entries from companies are welcome. However, in the case of a series, one programme ONLY should be submitted to represent the series as a whole.
- g) The documentary must be submitted for online viewing with a digital link (password protected Vimeo link is the preferred option).
- h) Completed Entry Form (Producer and Production details with digital link) and a digital publicity photograph must be submitted to mail@radharc.ie by 17.00 on 1st October 2018.
- i) In addition, a back-up DVD copy must be posted or delivered to:

- j) The Entry Fee for Category One is €25. The Entry Fee for Category Two is €15.
- k) All valid entries will be acknowledged.
- l) By submitting an entry, the entrants agree that an independent jury will have the final say as to the winners, and that the organising Committee shall be entitled to authorise any broadcaster to use a short clip or clips from any programme entry for the purposes of broadcast promotion of the competition or the award ceremony.
